Now Enrolling: Are you interested in your 8th grader becoming a Bengal Scholar? We are now accepting applications for the 2017-2018 school year. Night School: Students who fail any class (including advisory) are expected to make up the failing grade in night school. Night school is scheduled for the second semester and registration will open at the Quarter 2 Report Card Pickup. Science, Math, English, Spanish and History courses cost \$140 and Advisory costs \$70. All failing classes must be recovered in order for a student to be eligible for promotion.
