Enrichment Registration: Students must complete .25 enrichment credit hours per year in order to be promoted. All students will have the opportunity to learn more about their top three choices after watching the video in advisory on Monday, January 23rd. Registration begins January 24, 2017 and runs through January 31, 2017. Students will receive a registration form from their advisor. The completed form, including parent signature AND payment, are due to the Main Office by **Tuesday, January 31, 2017. NO LATE FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED, FORMS WITHOUT PAYMENT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** Space is limited so please get your signed form and payment in as soon as possible. PSAT/SAT Testing: Testing will be held Thursday, January 26, 2017. 9th/10th grade students will be dismissed at 12:00pm and 11th/12th grade students will be dismissed at 11:50am.

Report Card pick-up: Fees will no longer prevent you from picking up your student's report card. Report Card pick-up will take place on Friday, January 27th. You will be able to meet with your student's advisor and each of his/her teachers. Sessions will go from 2:00pm-4:00pm and 5:00pm-7:00pm. There will be a lunch break for teachers between 4:00pm-5:00pm and they will not be available for meetings. We want all parents to attend. Reach out to Ms. Rosario at 773-729-3411 for more details.

Night School: Students who fail any class (including advisory) are expected to make up the failing grade in night school. Night school is scheduled for the second semester and registration will open at the Quarter 2 Report Card Pickup. Science, Math, English, Spanish and History courses cost \$140 and Advisory costs \$70. All failing classes must be recovered in order for a student to be eligible for promotion.
