Bring back fashion from the 90s

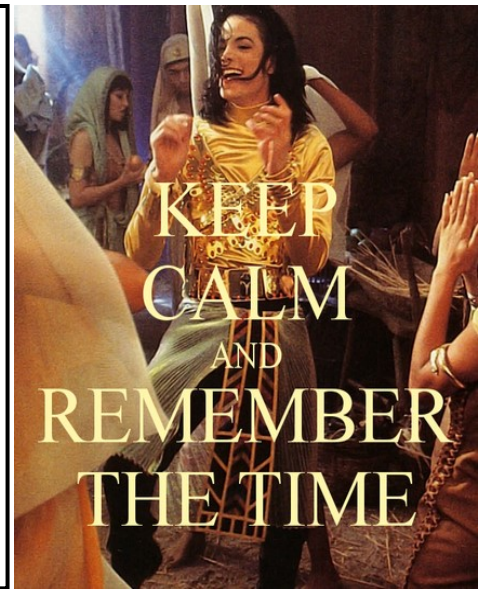
Thursday: Character Day
