Registration Open for Spring Break College Tour: The Spring Break College Tour is scheduled for April 9, 2017-April 12 2017 and we will be visiting several institutions in the Midwest. We have 60 spaces available on the trip that will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. If demand is high enough, we may add more spaces. The total cost of the trip is \$500 per student. In order to register, students must pay a \$150 deposit directly to Ms. Williams or Ms. Panduro by December 15th. Furthermore, payments of \$100 must be received by the 15th of each month until a total of \$500 has been paid no later than March 15, 2017. The trip must be paid in full by March 15, 2017 in order to attend. Credit card payments are accepted over the phone. If we do not have enough participants by **December 15th** this event will be canceled.
