Now Enrolling: Are you interested in your 8th grader becoming a Bengal Scholar? We are now accepting applications for the 2017-2018 school year. Siblings of current students are automatically enrolled upon completion of the application. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact Ms. Shelley.

Immunizations Junior Parents: This is a reminder regarding the mandated vaccine by the Illinois State Board of Education. Students are required to have a 2nd dose of the Meningitis (MCV4) vaccine at 16 years of age or older. If the 1st dose was given at age 16 or older; only one (1) dose will be required. Please provide proof of your student's immunization to the main office as soon as possible. Students may be excluded from school for not being in medical compliance. Medical Exemption Form: In order to be officially exempt from the Noble Post Physical Test, students must submit the Noble Medical Exemption Form by March 10, 2017. Without this medical exemption form, students who fail the Post Noble Physical Test anytime between March 10 and May 19 will be required to take the Noble Summer Fitness Program for promotion (unlimited re-takes are permitted). No retroactive medical documentation will exempt student from having to complete the Noble Summer Program. Additionally a regular doctor's form will not suffice. Students must turn in the NobleFit medical Form provided within this Newsletter.

ACT Boot Camp Mandatory for 11th graders: ACT Boot Camp will begin on March 10th and run through June 2nd (with the exception of 4/7, 4/14, and 4/28) for our 11th graders. Students will be marked tardy after 7:10am. These sessions are mandatory so our scholars can improve their scores for this important college entrance exam on June 10th.

12th Grade Students & Parents: Some of our students received a letter from "The National Society of High School Scholars" that advertises membership options into this society and the option to purchase a graduation cord to be worn at the ceremony. Please note that this organization is not associated with HCP or Noble, but is a private organization. Students received these letters based on their ACT performance and/or GPA via the College Board, and these cords will not be allowed to be worn during graduation. Scholars are free to join this organization at their discretion.

Detention: Every Thursday night from 4:00 pm - 6:00 pm the Culture team will run optional detention. This is an open invitation for all grade levels. Reach out to Mr. Enge with any questions.

Missed Detention: Starting March 10, 2017 any student who misses or are removed from detention will earn four demerits for the infraction.
