**Senior Deadline:** 12th graders must have 40 community service hours and 1.00 enrichment credit in order to graduate. Semester 2 deadline is **May 1st at 4:30pm** for 12th grade. All community service and enrichment documentation forms are due. No extensions will be given.

**Community Service Opportunity:** Remember students need to have 10 hours of community service yearly and 40 hours or more to graduate. **Immunizations-Junior Parents:** This is a reminder regarding the mandated vaccine by the Illinois State Board of Education. Students are required to have a 2nd dose of the Meningitis (MCV4) vaccine at 16 years of age or older. If the 1st dose was given at age 16 or older, only one (1) dose will be required. Please provide proof of your student's immunization to the main office as soon as possible. Students may be excluded from school for not being in medical compliance.
