Announcement: The South door will be closed to students and visitors post 8:05 AM starting Monday 04/03. If you have arrived post 8:05 AM please go to the North entrance (towards 87th street).

Immunizations-Junior Parents: This is a reminder regarding the mandated vaccine by the Illinois State Board of Education. Students are required to have a 2nd dose of the Meningitis (MCV4) vaccine at 16 years of age or older. If the 1st dose was given at age 16 or older, only one (1) dose will be required. Please provide proof of your student’s immunization to the main office as soon as possible. Students may be excluded from school for not being in medical compliance. ACT Boot Camp Mandatory for 11th graders: ACT Boot Camp will begin on March 10th and run through June 2nd (with the exception of 4/7, 4/14, and 4/28) for our 11th graders. Students will be marked tardy after 7:10am. These sessions are mandatory so our scholars can improve their scores for this important college entrance exam on June 10th.

Spring Break Double Detention: There will be double detention during Spring break for grade levels 9th-12th, April 10 - April 14, 2017. Doors will open at 7:30 am. Double detention is from 8:00 - 12:00 pm. Students with uniform infractions may not serve detention. Late arrivals will not gain entry.
