Enrichment Registration:

Tardy policy:

There will be a change in the tardy policy for 11th/12th grade students in Semester 2. In second semester for upperclassmen, along with the LaSalle policy changes, they will no longer get the "tardy buffer." As opposed to being late at 7:45 am, these students have until 7:55 am to be seated in their classes. Students who arrive at 7:55 am to school will receive the same consequence of 4D. Students arriving prior to 7:55 am will receive no consequence unless they are not seated in their 1st period class at the bell. Students arriving to class late will still receive tardy consequences. The idea for this switch is to continue to push our students to be responsible young adults. This policy went into effect officially January 22, 2018 and was communicated to parents at RCPU and to students during the Semester 2 awards.
